Be Suspicious of Potential Disinformation

Verify information is correct before you share anything on social media.



Don't Click on Advertisements

Only shop from trusted retailer websites. If a deal seems too good to be true, it probably is.



Beware of Fake Delivery Notifications

If you receive a notification for an unexpected delivery, don't click the link unless you've confirmed the purchase is real.



Be Careful Downloading Apps

Only download apps from your device's certified app store.
Confirm the publisher is trusted and if in doubt, don't install it.



Monitor Bank Account & Credit Card Activity
